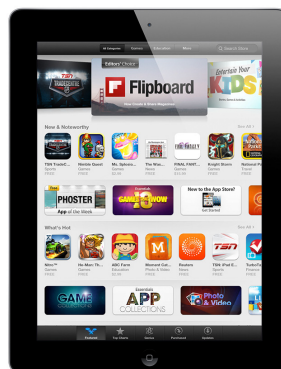

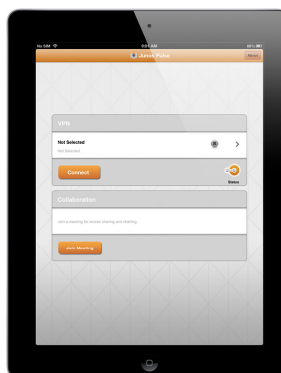
Your iPad must be running iOS 6.0 or greater.

Steps Overview

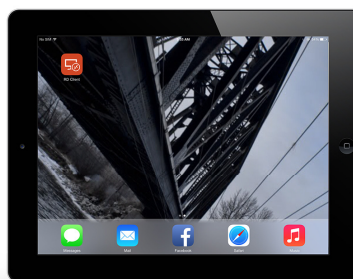
- 1 Go to the App Store and install both Microsoft Remote Desktop and Junos Pulse.



- 2 Open up Network Connect and configure a site to site VPN tunnel to <https://vpn2ppn.bc.ca>



- 3 Launch RD Client and set up a bookmark to go to (clinicname.wolfmedical.rdp)



1 Junos Pulse and Microsoft Remote Desktop Installation

1. Open the App Store icon on your iPad home screen.



2. In the top right corner tap **Search Store**

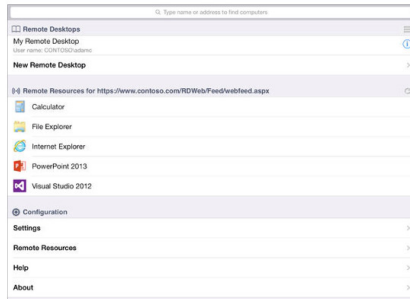
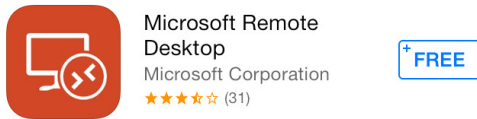


3. Type "Junos" and tap **Junos Pulse** from the Results list



4. Under **Junos Pulse** tap **FREE** and then **INSTALL**

5. In the top right corner tap the Search Box
6. Type “Microsoft Remote Desktop” and tap **Microsoft Remote Desktop** from the Results list
7. Under **Microsoft Remote Desktop** tap **Install**

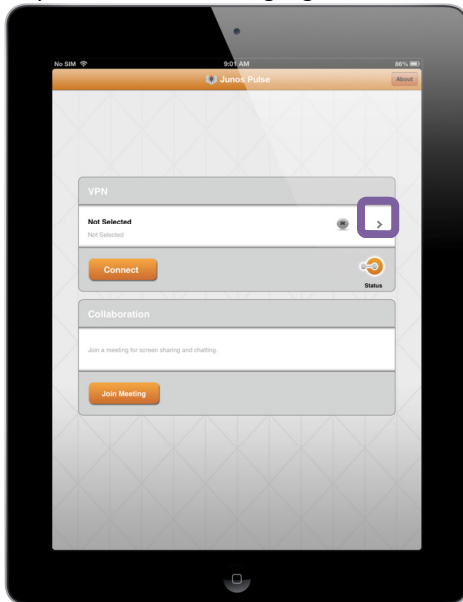


2 Setting up Junos Pulse

1. From the home screen tap **Junos Pulse**




2. Accept the Terms and Agreements by scrolling to the bottom and tapping **Accept**
3. Tap **Enable**
4. Tap the arrow that is highlighted in the screenshot below



5. In the Configuration window enter the following information:

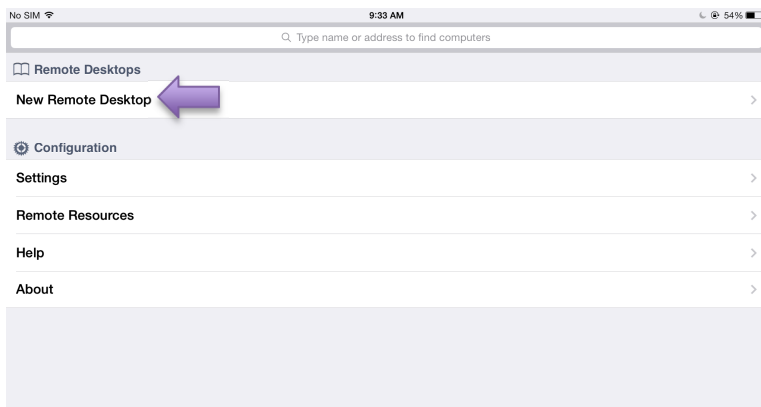
6. Tap **Save**

3 Setting up Microsoft RDP

1. From the home screen tap **RD Client**



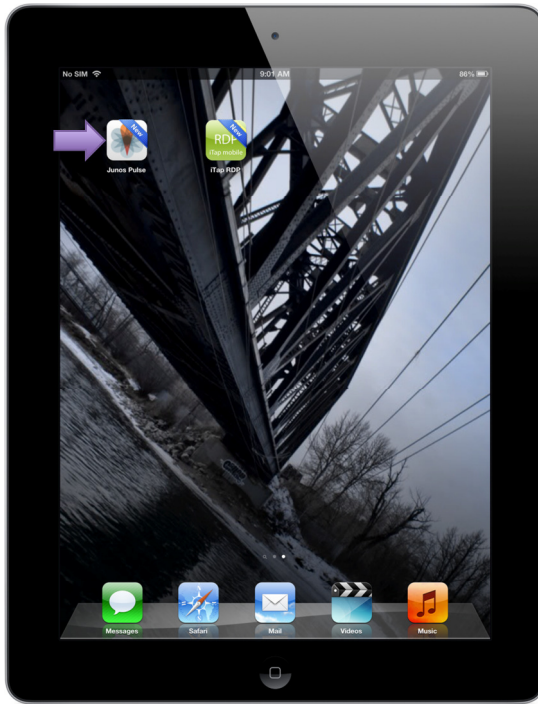
2. Tap **New Remote Desktop**



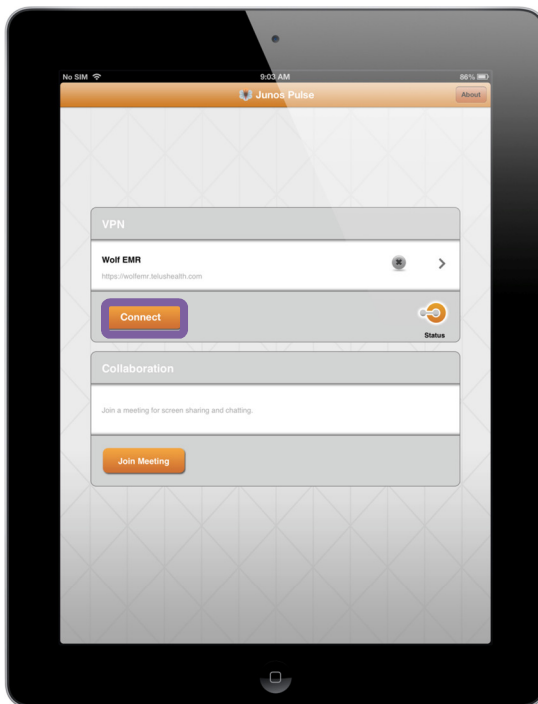
3. Fill in the Bookmark window as follows
Connection name: Wolf EMR
PC name: clinicname.wolfmedical.rdp
*Note: Each option opens in a separate page. To return to the original bookmark screen, tap **save***
4. Tap **User name** and enter the following information:
Account: wolfmedical\firstname.lastname
Password: (Leave blank)
Note: Click save in the top right corner to return to the bookmark
5. In the top left corner tap **Save**

4 Getting Connected

1. From the home screen tap **Junos Pulse**




2. Tap **Connect**




3. Log into the VPN appliance using the following information:

- a. **Username:** Firstname.Lastname\
- b. **Password:** PIN + Token Code

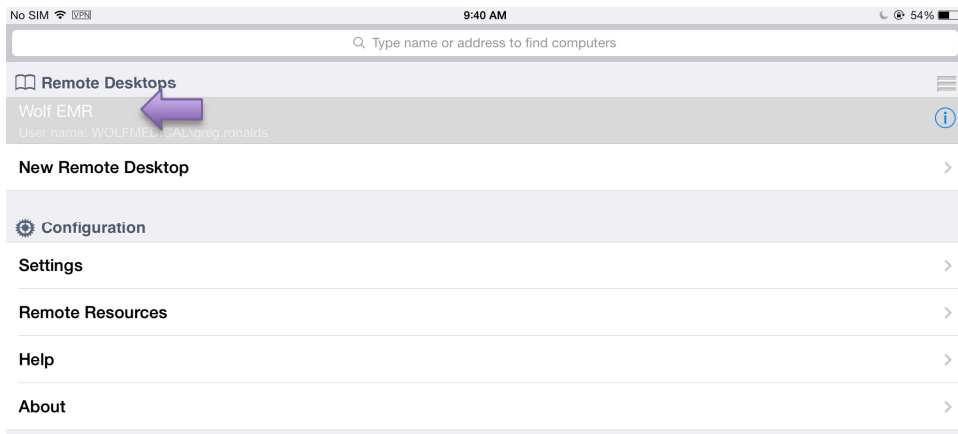

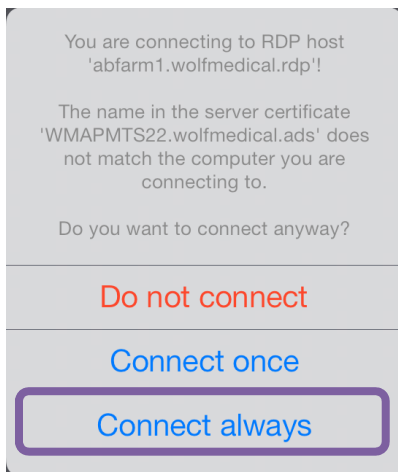
- From the home screen tap **RD Client**
